

Shubman Gill brings high-end water purifier to Indore

Indore: The Indian cricket team is in Indore ahead of the final ODI of the series against New Zealand, and strict precautions are being taken off the field to ensure players' health and fitness. As part of these measures, Indian captain Shubman Gill has brought a high-end water purification machine worth nearly

Rs 3 lakh, which has been installed in his hotel room. According to hotel sources, the machine is capable of purifying even RO-treated and packaged bottled water to the highest standards. While the hotel staff has not been briefed on the technical details of the purifier, the move reflects the

team's heightened alertness, especially in view of recent incidents of water contamination reported in Indore.

Bhopal: A deep wave of faith and devotion swept through Jain temples in Bhopal on the occasion of Lord Adinath's Moksha Kalyanak,

marking the liberation day of the first Tirthankara. From the early hours, devotees gathered in large numbers, and temples resonated

with chants of "Jai Ho Bade Baba Kundalpur" and "Jai Ho Bade Baba Chandkhedi."

Special rituals and anointments of Lord Adinath were performed during the Shri Adinath Vidhan, and Nirvana Laddus were offered on the auspicious occasion. Devotees recited the Bhaktamar and Namokar mantras, praying for peace and well-being of all. At Shantinath Jain Temple in Jain Nagar, special prayers were held under the guidance of Muni Vishok Sagar Maharaj and his disciples, who reminded devotees that life should be lived for liberation, not mere accumulation.

Temple committee spokesperson Saurabh Engineer said similar devotional programs were organized across major Jain temples of the city. Members of the Jain community participated with great reverence, making the celebrations a powerful expression of collective faith and spiritual reflection.

Synthetic Drug Lab busted in Neemuch

Neemuch: In a decisive strike against the rising synthetic drug menace, Neemuch Police dismantled a clandestine Mephedrone (MD) manufacturing unit in Khedi Dayama village on Friday. Acting on the state's "Zero Tolerance" policy, a massive force of 10 tactical teams—comprising personnel from six police stations—raided a suspected chemical storage facility. The operation led to the arrest of two traffickers, Rahul and Govind Banjara, while

a third accomplice, Prakash Banjara, remains at large.

The raid uncovered a sophisticated setup, turning the rural pocket into a synthetic drug hub. Officials seized high-grade MD drugs, raw materials worth Rs 30 lakh, 60 narcotic pills, and quantities of poppy straw and cannabis. Most notably, police recovered a currency counting machine, electronic scales, and records indicating the production of over 150 kilograms of synthetic

drugs. The total value of the seized haul is estimated at Rs 40 lakh. SP Ankit Jaiswal stated that the facility was equipped for large-scale production and distribution. A case has been registered under several sections of the NDPS Act at Manasa Police Station. This crackdown marks one of the most significant blows to the synthetic drug trade in the region, as authorities continue to hunt for the remaining members of the syndicate.

Fake Google job scam in Indore

Brothers swindled of Rs 15 lakh

Indore: In a sophisticated cybercrime case, two brothers from Indore were allegedly defrauded of over Rs 15.15 lakh by a Punjab-based fraudster promising lucrative careers at tech giant Google. The Indore Crime Branch has registered a case against the prime suspect, Rishabh Kumar, and his accomplices.

The web of deceit: The victim, Ayush Kumar, met Rishabh online in 2019. To gain trust, Rishabh initially hired Ayush for website projects and made timely payments. Once credible, Rishabh claimed to work under a "Senior Zonal Head" at Google and offered Ayush a Digital Marketing Manager role, while promising his brother, Piyush, a senior executive position in Hungary.

Sophisticated forgery: Between 2022 and 2023, the scammers extracted Rs 15,15,221 in installments. The funds were demanded under various pretexts, including background verification, English certification, and embassy fees. To maintain the illusion, the fraudsters conducted interviews via Google Hangouts and issued high-quality forged joining letters and agreements bearing fake corporate seals.

The reality check: The scam unraveled when joining dates were repeatedly postponed. After the suspects stopped responding in March 2024, the victims approached the police. Authorities have now booked Rishabh Kumar, Amitosh Bhat-tacharya, and Kavita Raichand for fraud and forgery.
