Cong slams safety lapse after sewer deaths in Indore

By Special Correspondent Bhopal: The Madhya Pradesh Congress has expressed concern over the death of two sanitation workers during sewer cleaning in Indore on March 2. The workers, Karan and Ajay, died while cleaning a sewer chamber near Chaitram Hospital Gate in the city, which has been ranked India's cleanest for eight consecutive years.

State Congress spokesperson Praveen Dholpure described the incident as deeply tragic and indicative of administrative negligence and disregard for safety standards. He said sanitation workers who keep cities clean are often forced to enter sewers without adequate protective equipment, putting their lives at risk. Dholpure demanded Rs 1 crore compensation for each bereaved family, a permanent government job for a family member, and Rs 25 lakh assistance with free treatment for injured workers. He also sought criminal action against officials responsible for the lapse.

Lawrence Bishnoi gang member arrested for Rs 10-crore extortion plot

Ashoknagar: Ashoknagar Police have neutralized a significant threat to the local business community by arresting Manish Jageer, an active member of the notorious Lawrence Bishnoi gang. Operating from a private hotel, Jageer was apprehended following a sophisticated surveillance operation after he allegedly demanded a staggering Rs 10-crore ransom from local businessman Ankit Agarwal. During the raid, authorities recovered seven lethal petrol bombs, a motorcycle, and several



forged identification cards. Investigations led by SP Rajiv Kumar Mishra revealed that Jageer, a Rajasthan native, was actively conducting a reconnaissance of the businessman's residence with the intent to execute a violent strike. Shockingly, police uncovered a trail of digital footprints connecting him to international crime syndicates, including evidence of transactions via

cryptocurrency and direct transfers from Goa and Madhya Pradesh. His mobile device yielded definitive proof of communication with gang kingpins Harry Boxer and Hrithik Boxer, both of whom have been named in the formal FIR. This high-profile arrest exposes the gang's expanding reach into the heart of India and their shift toward tech-savvy extortion methods. Police remain on high alert as they trace the broader network behind this daring extortion bid.
