

Patwari prays with bereaved families

By Special Correspondent Bhopal: Several families in Indore have lost their loved ones in the tragic incident caused by contaminated water, leaving the community in deep grief. In the wake of the tragedy, Madhya Pradesh Congress Committee president Jeetu Patwari joined the bereaved families and offered prayers for the departed souls.

Patwari attended a programme in Bhagirathpura where the relatives of the deceased had gathered before leaving for Prayagraj to immerse the ashes of their loved ones. During the gathering, he expressed heartfelt condolences to the grieving families and prayed for peace for the departed souls.

Speaking on the occasion, Patwari said the loss suffered by the



families in the contaminated water tragedy was deeply painful and had shaken the entire community. He stood with the affected families during their moment of grief and prayed for strength and courage for them to endure the irreparable loss.

He also offered prayers for the eternal peace of those who died in the tragedy and wished that such an incident never occurs again. "I pray to God to keep our Madhya Pradesh safe from any such tragedies in the future," he said.

The families later departed for Prayagraj to perform the ritual of immersing the ashes in the sacred waters, while local residents and leaders expressed solidarity with them during this difficult time.

Oil companies must take steps to ensure timely availability of LPG

ACS Shami issues directives during a meeting

Administrative Correspondent Bhopal: A review meeting was held on Saturday with senior officials of the Ministry and representatives of oil companies to assess the potential impact on the state. During the review, Additional Chief Secretary (ACS) Rashmi Arun Shami issued directives to take necessary measures to ensure the timely availability of gas cylinders for domestic consumers and to maintain a smooth distribution system through various agencies. The representatives of the oil companies were also instructed to ensure a regular supply of LPG across all districts of the state.

The meeting also included a review of the operations of gas agencies, the punctuality of cylinder distribution, and the status of complaints received from consumers. In this regard, instructions had already been issued to all District Collectors stating that if any complaints regarding irregularities or delays in the distribution system are received, immediate action must be taken to ensure that gas is made available to consumers in a timely manner.

Furthermore, special attention is to be paid to the availability of LPG in both urban and rural areas, and coordination with gas companies is to be strengthened to reinforce the supply chain, thereby ensuring the uninterrupted availability of LPG throughout the state. Continuous action is also being taken against the black marketing and hoarding of LPG. According to the information received, on March 13, enforcement actions were carried out at 11 locations across the state, resulting in the seizure of 228 cylinders and the registration of 3 cases.

Adequate stock of gas cylinders

Ajay Srivastava, the State Nodal Officer for oil companies, stated that there is an adequate stock of gas cylinders available in the state, with sufficient supplies currently held at the state's 11 bottling plants and various distributor warehouses. Inconvenience was being experienced due to the excessive load on the server caused by apprehensive consumers; this issue has now been resolved.

AIIMS marks World Glaucoma Week with awareness drive



Bhopal: AIIMS Bhopal observed World Glaucoma Week from March 8 to 14 with a series of awareness and screening activities aimed at educating the public about glaucoma and the importance of early eye check-ups. The initiative was organized by the Department of Ophthalmology under the guidance of Executive Director and CEO Madhabananda Kar.

Throughout the week, doctors and health workers conducted awareness campaigns through posters, banners, pamphlet distribution, health talks and street plays to inform people about the symptoms, risks and prevention of glaucoma. Eye screening camps were also or-

ganized where citizens received free eye examinations and expert consultations.

Head of the Ophthalmology Department Bhavana Sharma explained that glaucoma is a serious eye disease caused by increased pressure inside the eye, which damages the optic nerve and can lead to permanent vision loss if not detected in time.

The institute also used social media platforms to spread awareness through informative videos and interactive messages. Doctors urged people, especially those with a family history of glaucoma, to undergo regular eye check-ups for early detection and timely treatment.

Dial-112 team rescues injured peacock



By Special Correspondent Bhopal: The Dial-112 emergency service of Madhya Pradesh Police is playing a vital role not only in providing police assistance but also in protecting wildlife. In a recent incident in Morena District, the timely response

of Dial-112 personnel ensured treatment for an injured Indian Peafowl, the national bird of India.

According to officials, the State-level Dial-112 Police Control Room in Bhopal received information on March 13 that a peacock had been found injured under unclear circumstances in Sihora village under the Noorabad police station area. Immediately after receiving the alert, a Dial-112 First Response Vehicle was dispatched to the spot.

Constable Ravi Kumar and pilot Anshul Sharma found the bird injured after apparently straying from a nearby forest. The team carefully secured the peacock and transported it in the response vehicle to a forest centre in Morena, where it was handed over to officials of the Forest Department for treatment.

The injured bird is currently receiving medical care. Officials said the incident highlights the commitment of the Dial-112 service to both public safety and wildlife protection.
